The scoring of the reading selection tests are very different from the past years. There are four formative grades given on the weekly reading test. The four areas are; vocabulary, word analysis, comprehension, and a writing score.

This week's reading selection is The Horned Toed Princess which is a Trickster Tale. We will also be learning about Fables. The comprehension skill is author's purpose and the comprehension strategy is story structure. The tested vocabulary words are; bargain, favor, lassoed, offended, prairie, riverbed, and shrieked.



Our focus on word analysis this week will be on compound words and our vocabulary skill will center on synonyms and antonyms. The fourth graders will also be writing a personal narrative.

Students have caught on quickly to our new spelling curriculum Words Their Way. Students have their new words in their binders to practice their sorts at home. Each child also has a username and password for SpellingCity. This is a great site to reinforce spelling patterns.
